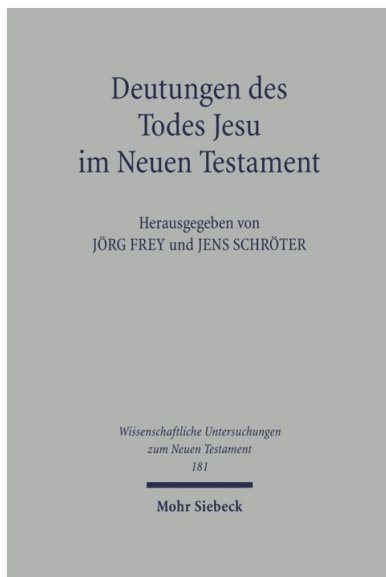


Deutungen des Todes Jesu im Neuen Testament
