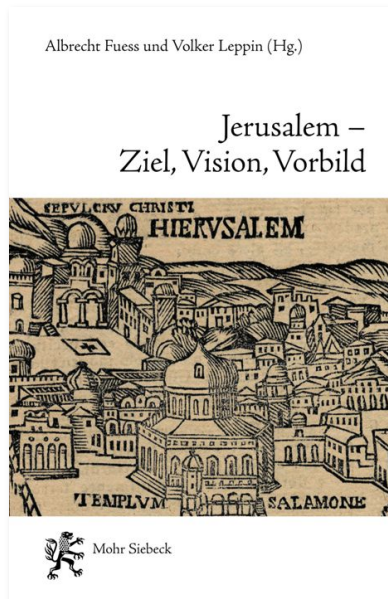


Jerusalem - Ziel, Vision, Vorbild

Jerusalem combines the expectations and hopes of the classical monotheistic religions of Judaism, Christianity, and Islam as well as the modern religion of Baha'i. The volume examines how the city and these places were dealt with in the different strands of religious history.
