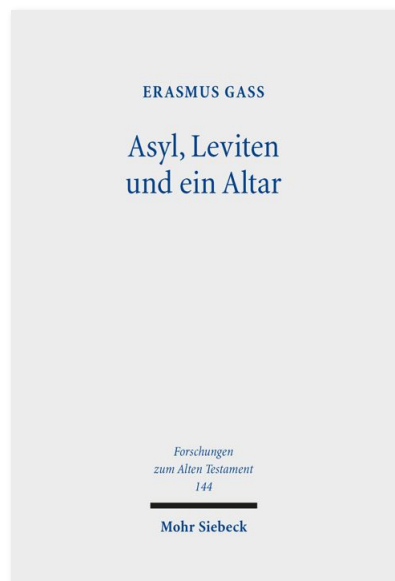


Erasmus Gaß
