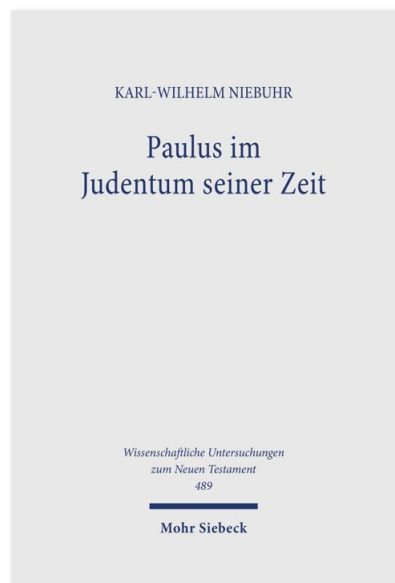


Karl-Wilhelm Niebuhr
