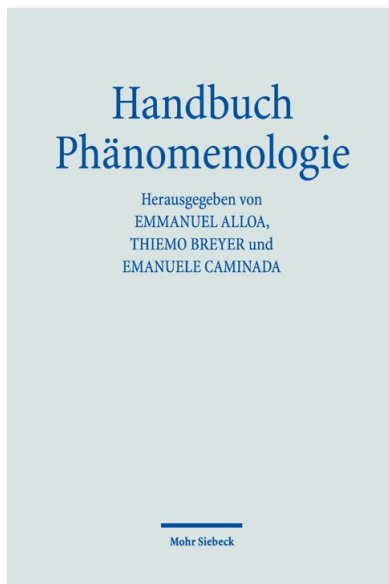


# Handbuch Phänomenologie
