Ambiguity has always been an issue in philosophy. But because only the unambiguous can be known with certainty and philosophy has been devoted to knowledge and its truth, the ambiguous has been marginalized and devalued. In contrast Günter Figal argues for a philosophy that takes ambiguity seriously and essentially is a phenomenological, aesthetic and hermeneutical exploration of the ambiguous and its perceptual experience.

Günter Figal (1949-2024): 1976 PhD; 1987 Habilitation; 1989-2002 Professor of Philosophy at the University of Tübingen; since 2002 Professor for Philosophy at the University of Freiburg im Breisgau; since 2017 emeritus.
