

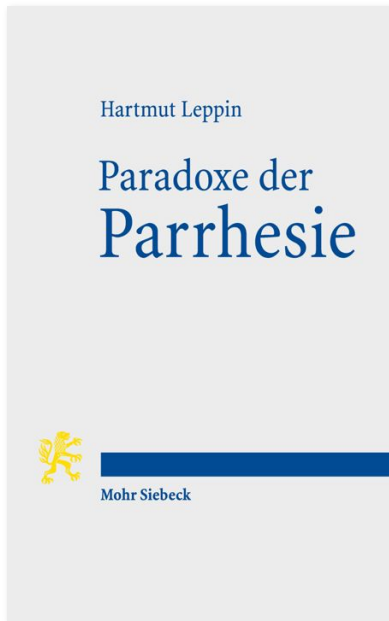
Hartmut Leppin
